These volunteers will be asked to meet with "their student" weekly to help them learn basic skills such as multiplication tables, English vocabulary words and other fundamental skills necessary to navigate high school in the United States. Though teaching skills or high level class room skills would be welcome they are not required!

To get started as a volunteer, the Pencil Foundation will require both an application and a background check. Both forms can be found at www.pencilfoundation.org. 30-60minute/week commitment for 12 weeks is necessary to build a relationship and end in success.
