

Summer Reading for Rising Second Graders

This summer it is important to keep emerging readers practicing the skills they've learned in 1st grade. The second grade reading list for summer has books grouped into three categories by reading level. Students should choose books at their independent reading level, meaning they need help with no more than one out of twenty-five words.

Students should read at least one book per week through the summer. Please use the reading calendar included with the book list to record the books read. This should be verified by the parent's signature.

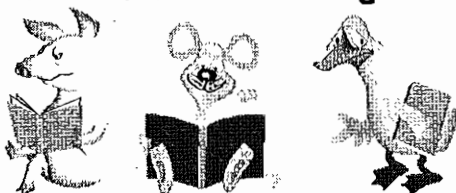
There will be four "**Book Parties**" for 2nd grade throughout the summer to share reading experiences with each other and with Mrs. Woodman. Each book party will last approximately 30 minutes and will be held in the West Wing. The teacher will do a book share with students at the book party and have small door prizes. Students should bring a book they have completed from the book list and an item that will help them tell about their book. For example, if I had read Cinderella, I might bring a clock to tell about what happens when the clock strikes midnight. Students should be prepared to tell about their book and read a favorite part aloud.

All students should try to come to *at least one* book party, but are invited to come to all four parties. The parties are designed to support and encourage reading and help the students and teacher get to know one another. Students who are *unable to attend* any book parties will be required to turn in *2 book reports* on the first day of school using the format provided in this packet.
