Dear Parents:

As the month of December approaches, I would like to remind parents and students of the uniform policy that will take effect November 30th when we transition to winter uniforms. The full text appears on page thirteen in the student handbook.

The winter uniform includes long slacks, jumpers, and/or skirts, and full skorts (skirt goes all around) from Parker Uniforms. Walking shorts **or half skorts** (back looks like a pair of shorts) may not be worn after this date. In cold weather, girls may wear navy, black, or white tights. No leggings or Capri tights are allowed. The navy blue uniform sweater is also a **required** part of the winter uniform. Sweaters may be purchased from Parker and may be (1) long sleeve pullover, (2) sleeveless pullover, or (3) cardigan. Solid white turtlenecks may be worn under the shirt or blouse.

Red fleece pullovers or vests **with the CKS logo** may be worn instead of a sweater. Sweaters and fleeces should be neat and well fitting. No oversized layers or lengths beyond the student's hip are allowed. Please note that sweatshirts with hoods or other jackets may **not** be worn, even those with a CKS logo. The red fleece pullover or vest may be purchased from the CKS Spirit Store. If you wish to make a purchase, send the order form and payment in an envelope marked H&S to the office. Forms are available by downloading from the CTK Website, www.ctl.org/school and go to "Spirit Store."

A uniform sweater, pullover or vest should have been purchased for your child by now, but I remind you once again that its use will be **required** beginning November 30th. **Students should come to school dressed accordingly each school day.** If weather conditions are such that students will be uncomfortable in the classroom, they will be allowed to remove their sweaters, and/or fleece (at the teacher's discretion). They will take their fleece/sweater from class to class as different locations have different temperatures. **Please make certain that your child's sweater has his/her name written clearly inside.** Any misplaced sweaters will be sent to the lost and found. We encourage you to look in lost and found for an already missing sweater as we have many without homes.

Please note that during freezing or inclement weather, students must wear an outer layer of clothing for protection. Student pullovers and sweaters alone are not adequate coverage for cold days. Students may layer over or under their fleece/sweaters with a coat, sweater or sweatshirt that can be removed after recess.

I appreciate your cooperation as we transition to the winter uniform.
