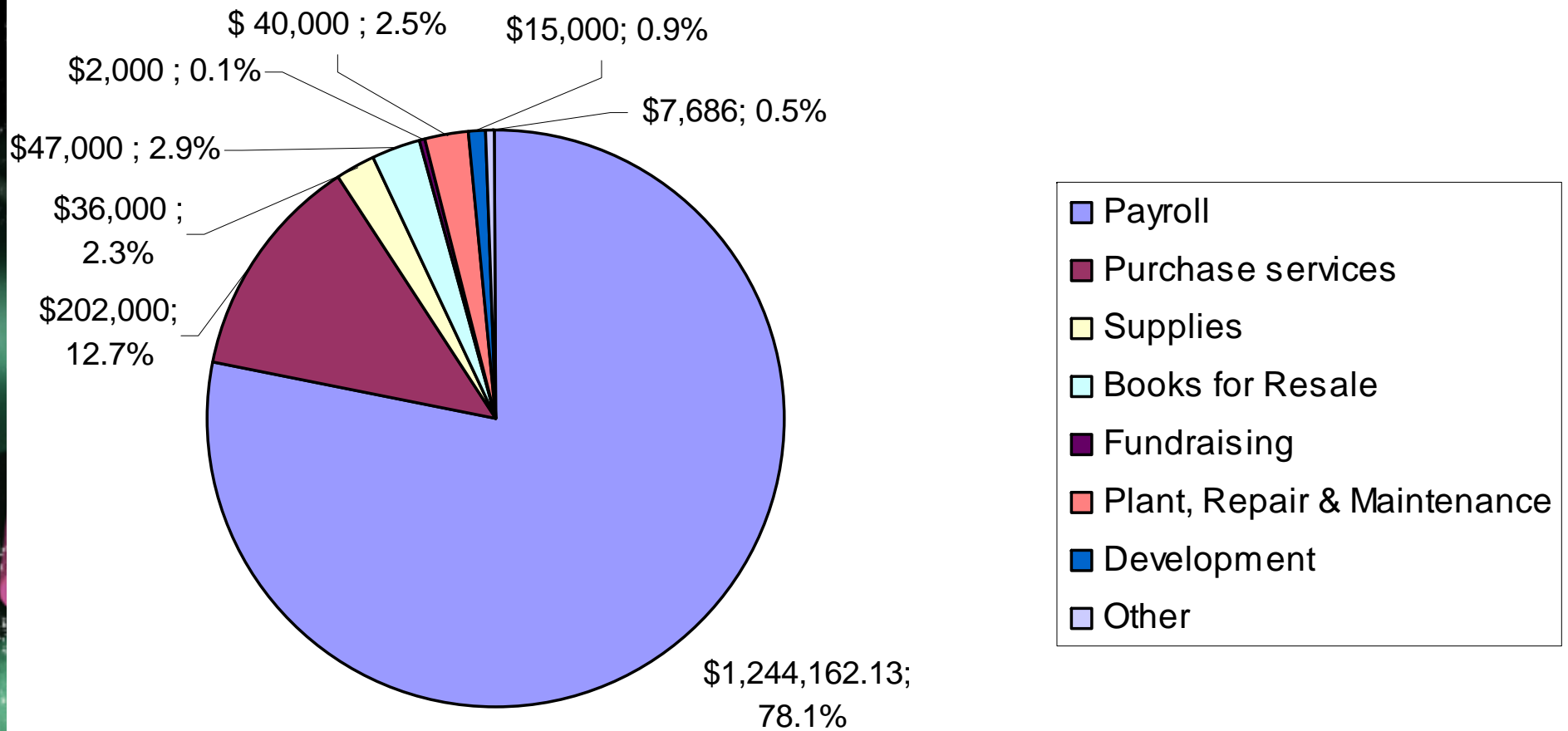

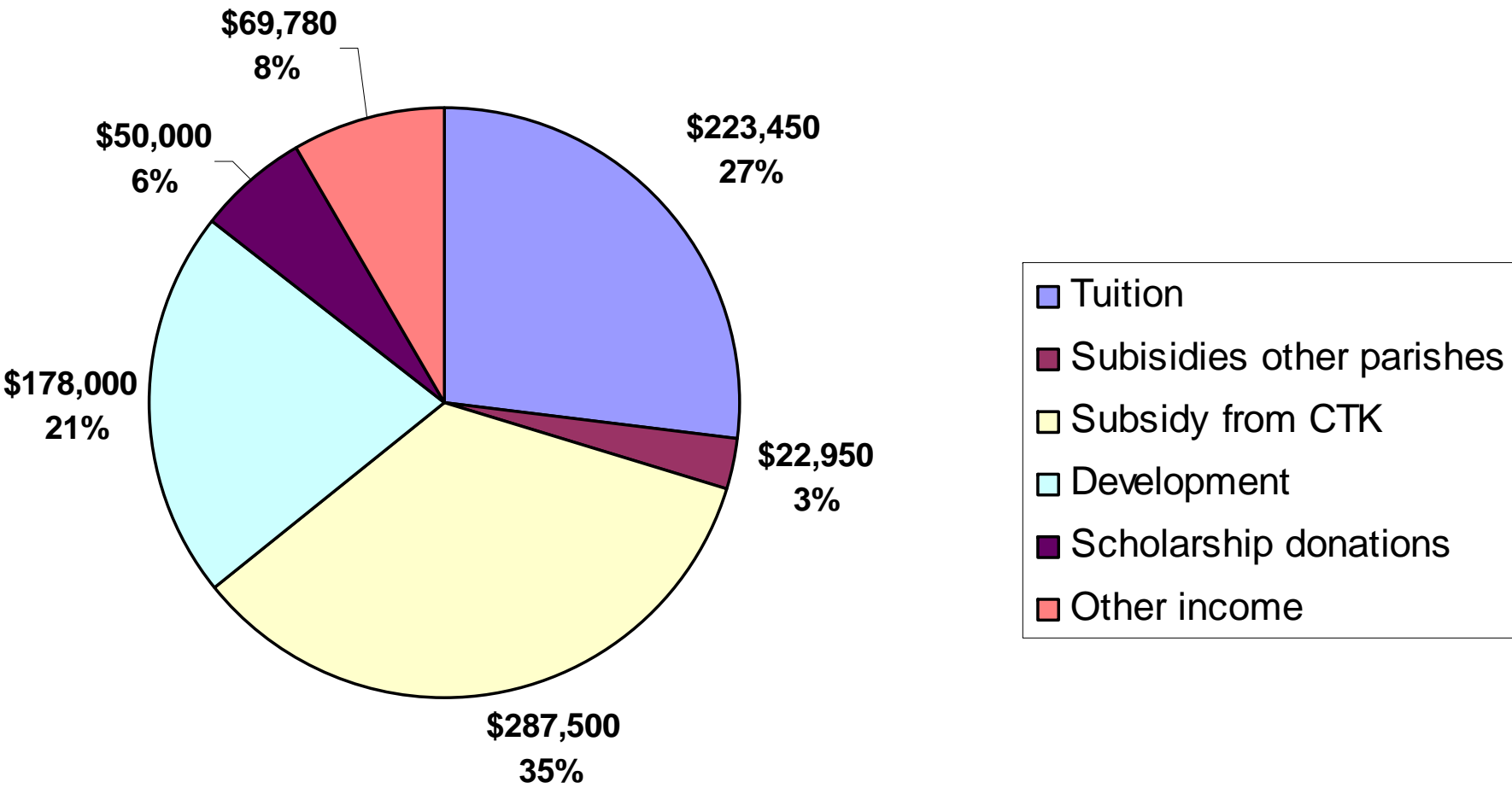
# SERVICE AND STEWARDSHIP

# Stewardship

- TREASURE

Tuition payments

Parish Subsidy of \$285,000.00

Annual Giving which is tax deductible; Goal of \$80,000

Sponsorship opportunities for businesses

Box tops, Publix, Harris Teeter, Target, Office Depot,  
Recycling, UPROMISE

Raider Rewards Program (Scrip and Kroger)

Earned \$18,000 for school last year

Full Family participation would raise = \$33,600



# Raider Rewards

- **Each store gives CKS a percentage**

For example: You purchase a \$10 Starbucks card

Starbucks gives 7% and .70 was just earned for CKS/You

- **Shopping at Kroger is Another Way to Earn Raider Rewards—  
Kroger gives 4%**

You add \$200 to card-- Kroger gives 4% and \$8 was just earned for CKS/You

In just 25 weeks (less than half a year), you have reached your \$200 and thereafter all funds go to **your** tuition costs

- If you used only the Starbucks and Kroger cards every week for the entire year, **you** would earn \$200 for CKS and \$252.40 towards **your** tuition assistance.
- **Use on items you would normally purchase as everyday use--- groceries, gas, movie tickets, clothing. The earnings add up!**

\*\*Once you get the \$200 the rest goes towards your family's tuition. Fourteen families already reached their \$200 goal for this school year
