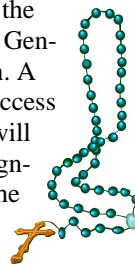
was due Friday, May 14th. There is still time to participate and earn rebates for CKS if you haven't yet.

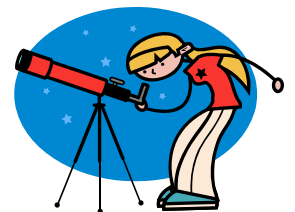

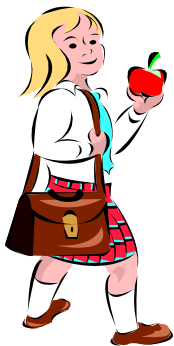
